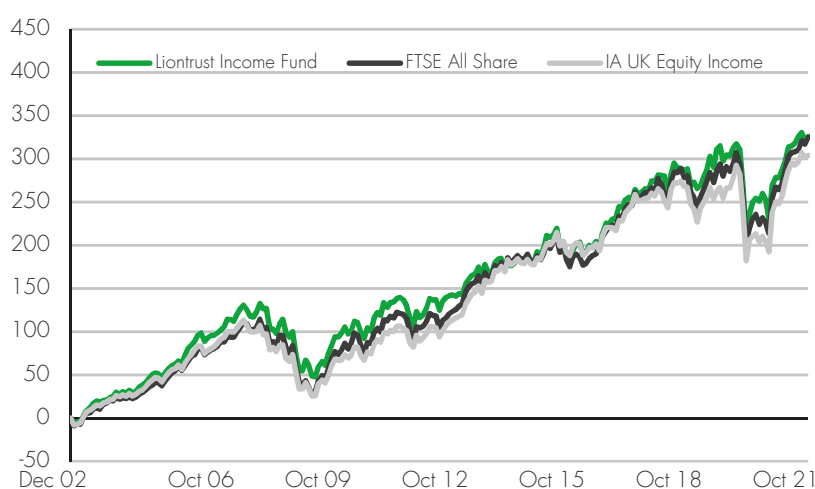

A dividend cover of 2 times means the company's profits are twice the amount being paid as a dividend, whilst a company with a dividend cover of 1 times is paying out a dividend equal to all of its net profits.
