

Effective 8th February 2021 the minimum initial subscription amount for investors seeking to purchase Class 3, Class 7 or Class Z shares have increased from £200,000,000 to £500,000,000. In addition the minimum holdings for these classes has increased from £150,000,000 to £450,000,000. Note that there is no impact for any existing investors already in these classes.

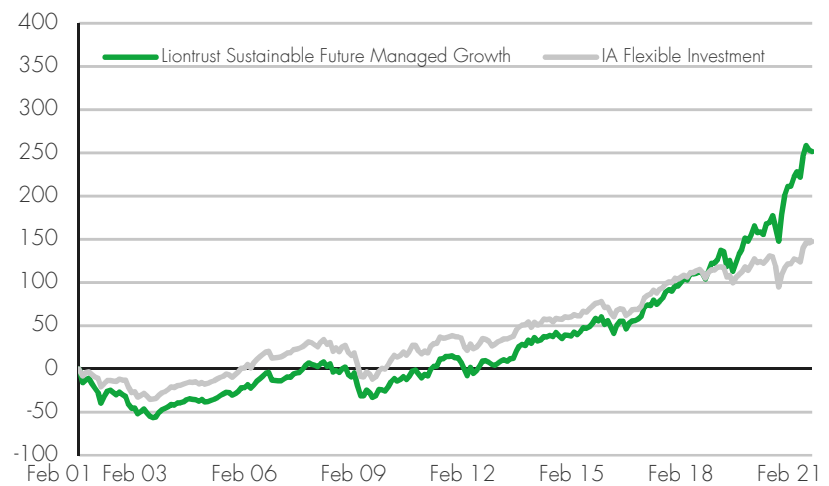
